

Preparing a safe and effective learning environment for supplementary education

Local authority/agency commissions **3-day Good Management course** for group of up to 10 schools (ideally each school sends MC member and teacher). **Cost £1,350** (plus travel)

Each school receives 12-month subscription to NRCSE resources, templates, good practice to support learning throughout the course

Local authority/agency provides staff member to train as quality mentor. NRCSE provides training over two days (generally a month apart) and accompanies mentors on two school visits. Training of up to 5 local authority/agency mentor(s) £700 (plus travel)

Individual school subscribes, to access online resources & templates. Completes and uploads 'Management File'.

(Discounted access to 3-day Good Management course)

Cost £25

'Appropriate person'
(eg. mainstream school teacher)
visits school and writes a
witness statement.

Appropriate person (mentor or other qualified professional) provides school with 'Witness Statement' confirming what practices they observed, what activities were take place and reporting on teaching and learning observed.

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Each school logs in to their profile on NRCSE website, enters school details in full, completes self-assessment, submits mentor's witness statement and registers for a quality assurance recognition meeting £130

NRCSE calls and chairs recognition meeting –

1 to 4 school(s) attend plus an independent education professional.

Schools present management file and portfolio of evidence

NRCSE issues certificate of quality assurance for the school Certificate is dated and records specific good practice observed
