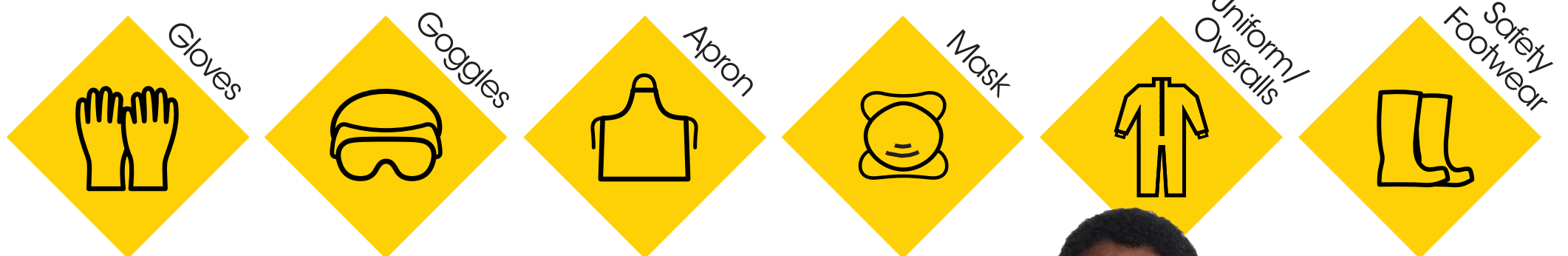


Safety First

ARE YOU PROTECTED WHEN USING CHEMICALS?



EMERGENCY ACTION



EYE CONTACT

Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Get immediate medical advice/attention.



INHALATION

Remove victim to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Call a poison centre or doctor/physician if you feel unwell.



SKIN CONTACT

Wash skin with plenty of water. Remove/Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. If skin irritation occurs, get medical advice/attention.



INGESTION

If swallowed: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. Call a poison centre or doctor/physician if you feel unwell.
