

Enhancing the effectiveness and inclusiveness of **labour markets** and **access to quality employment** through developing social infrastructure and promoting social economy (SO 4.1).

Ensuring equal access to **health care** and fostering resilience of health systems, including primary care, and promoting the transition from institutional to family-and-community-based care (SO 4.5).

Enhancing the role of **culture and sustainable tourism** in economic development, social inclusion and social innovation (SO 4.6).

### **Types of projects**



#### Projects are expected to:

- Jointly tackle common territorial challenges and/or opportunities.
- **Develop / test / adapt new or existing approaches and implement** them in different contexts (e.g., regions, sectors, environments, etc.)
- Aim at the further dissemination, uptake and roll-out of the approach developed.





### **Types of activities**



A **combination** of at least 2 of the following activities:

- Elaboration and implementation of joint strategies and/or action plans
- Joint development and implementation of pilot actions testing tools and/or solutions
- Capacity building and awareness raising activities (incl. joint trainings)

#### **Eligibility aspects**


- **3 partners** from 3 different countries
- At least 2 partners from the NWE area
- Partners outside the NWE area can join if well justified

- **Project partner**








### What makes a good project?








1) A good project:

"clearly defines its needs and relevance to the NWE area"

A) place-based approach

B) not a stand-alone initiative,
but embedded in an overall strategic
framework





A good project:

"contributes to Programme objectives"

A) achieve one Programme SO

- + specific challenges
- + opportunities + identify the territory







#### "has measurable results"

- A) Programme indicator framework
- B) as clear as possible









"embeds transnational cooperation at its core"

Explain added value of the transnational approach










"builds on existing knowledge and goes beyond existing approaches"

- + develops and tests new approaches
- + and/or adapting and implementing existing approaches in different contexts













"has a strong partnership structure"

- + gov./public org.
- + industry/businesses
- + research/academia
- + civil society/citizen groups










### A good project:

"makes a lasting change and plants its long-term effects"

- + tangible strategies, solutions and concepts
- + transnational product, service, process, solution, ...







"communicates its project activities and results"

- + communication strategy
- + project specific + tailored to needs
- + defined target audience
- + upscaling of project results + "tell the story"
