De Wet holds a BAcc.LLB degree from Stellenbosch University and joined PwC's corporate and international tax team in Cape Town as a Tax Consultant in 2011. During his time at PwC, he provided tax consulting services to various local and multinational groups which included advice on group restructurings, mergers and acquisitions, capital gains tax, and share incentive schemes.

He is an admitted advocate of the High Court of South Africa, registered Business Restructuring Professional, and registered Tax Practitioner. De Wet also currently serves as the Secretary-General for the South African branch of the International Fiscal Association.
