15 MAMMAL SPECIES EXCLUDING BATS



5 Jaguars including 2 different pairs of mating pairs. Observed in day and night drives.



1 Puma at 4am running in front of our 4WD

2 Jaguarundi sightings on dusk. Same cat as it was in the same area. Reddish coat.

4 Ocelot sightings. Frequently seen in soya fields and on roads.

Neotropical Otter seen 2 times, once on the road.



Red Howler Monkey: Many family groups on route to the property and on the reserve.

Collared Peccaries: Brief sightings in soya fields

Coatis: Many groups observed

Brown throated 3 toed Sloth: Many sightings on route and in the Reserve

Bolivian Pink Dolphins: 2 seen sadly trapped in lagoons

Capybara: hundreds

7 Banded Armadillo, seen on route to the Property

Marsh deer: Seen frequently in Pampas areas.



Grey Brocket deer: Seen frequently at both day and night

Azaria Agouti.

Species we missed: LOWLAND TAPIR, WHITE LIPPED PECCARIES, TAYRA, GIANT ANTEATER, SQUIRREL MONKEY, and BROWN TUFFED CAPUCHIN MONKEYS.

In 6 trips to this property we have had a 100 percent record of Jaguar sightings, Marsh deer, Ocelot and Pink Dolphins.
