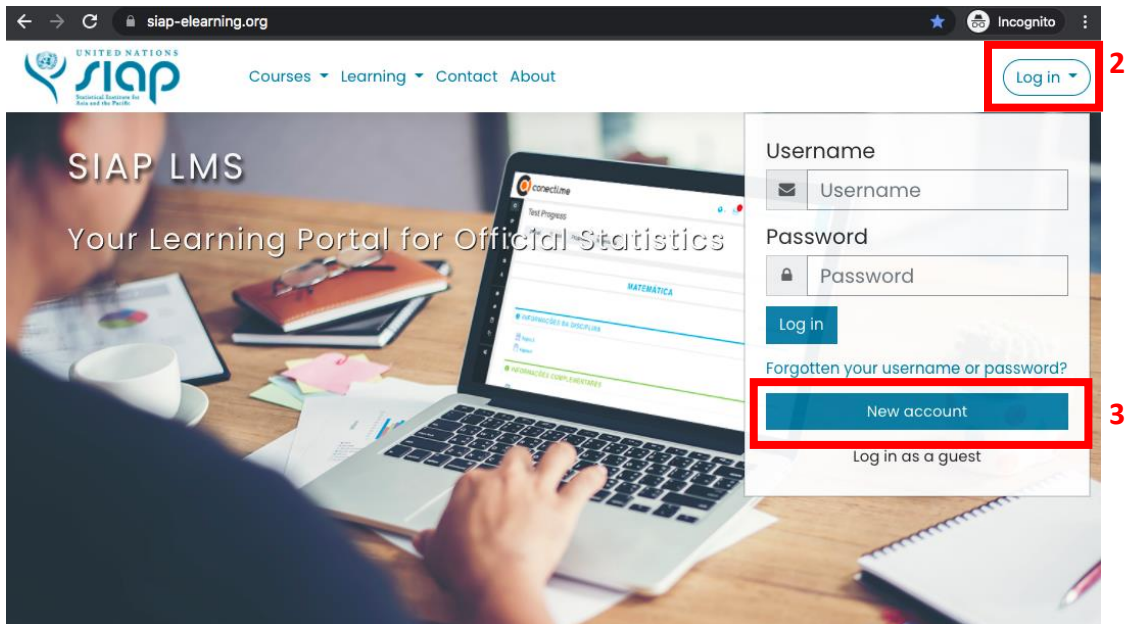


## Steps for creating an account and self-registering on the E-learning Platform

1. Go to the website: <https://siap-elearning.org/>
2. Click on the log in button.
3. Select “New Account” from the drop-down menu.



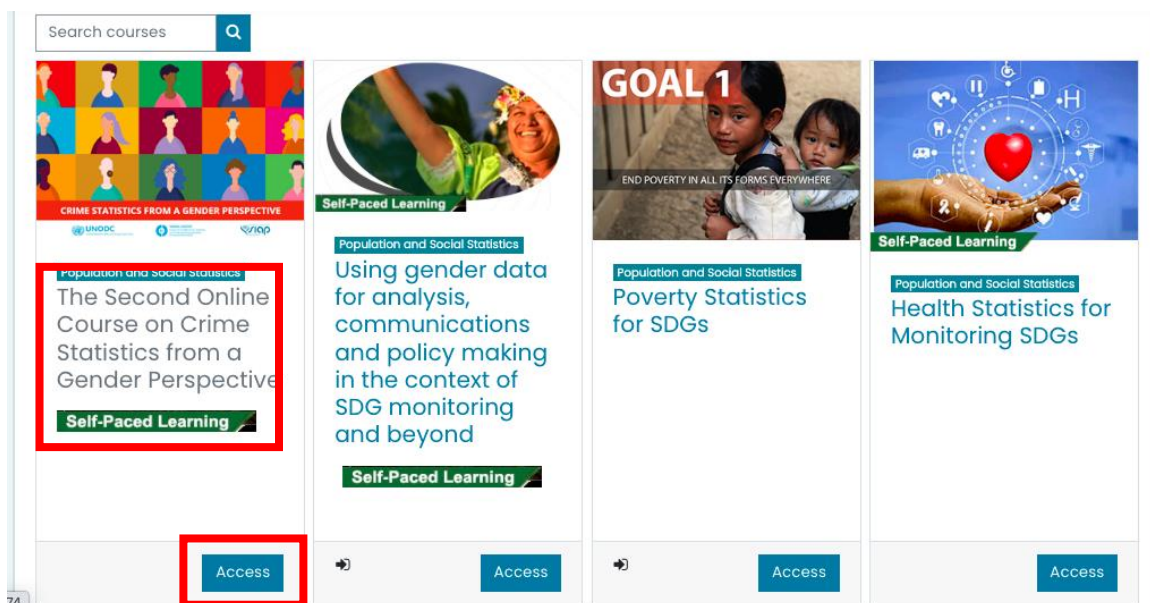
4. Complete all of the fields in the registration for required to set up your account. **Be sure to enter your names (First Name and Surname) correctly and exactly how it should appear on your certificate.**

8. To enroll for a course, you need to first log in to the e-learning system, using the credentials (username and password) created when you first set up the account.
9. On the main menu (right of the SIAP logo), click on **Course** and from the drop-down menu select **Population and Social Statistics**.
10. Select the course "**Second Online Course on Crime Statistics from a Gender Perspective**" from the list of **Available Courses** on **Population and Social Statistics**. [You can either click on the name of the course or the button "**Access**"]



11. You will be prompted to "self enrol" for the course. **Click on "Enrol me"**. This will enroll you in the Course. Once you have successfully enrolled, you will also receive an email welcoming you to the course.
